Chapter 1 — Why AI Creates So Much Confusion

This is probably the biggest fear surrounding AI. Many headlines suggest entire careers will disappear. The reality is far more balanced.

Throughout history, technology has changed jobs rather than eliminating work altogether.

Email didn't replace office workers. Computers didn't eliminate accountants. The internet didn't stop businesses hiring people.

Instead, technology changed how people worked. AI is likely to do exactly the same.

People who learn how to work with AI will often become more productive than those who ignore it.

The future belongs to people who combine human judgement with AI tools.

Chapter 4 — Myth: AI Is Always Correct

AI often sounds extremely confident. That doesn't always mean it's right.
